## July 21st: Traumatic Brain Injury 101

## July 28th: TBI Special Behaviors

Behavioral problems following TBI present tremendous challenges to family members as well as those working with persons who have a TBI. These behaviors can interfere with all aspects of individuals' lives; rate of recovery, safety issues, the ability to socialize, etc. This session will cover behaviors that are common following brain injury and will provide approaches to dealing with behaviors using Positive Behavior Supports.

## August 4th: TBI & Community Outcomes

After initial rehabilitation and stabilization, it is critical that individuals are offered the opportunity to integrate back into the community. This last part of our TBI series will focus on the need to integrate individuals back into the community and will address issues associated with that transition.
